

Finance Committee Chair (Voluntary)

The North East Anti-Racism Coalition, NEARC, is a growing movement that came together in response to the unrest in summer 2024. We are a broad-based coalition united by the belief that embracing our diversity strengthens the region—economically, socially, and culturally.

With new funding secured to support our mission, we have established a **Finance Committee** to ensure strong financial oversight. We are now seeking a chair of this committee.

NEARC is in the process of becoming an independent organisation, a Charitable Incorporated Organisation, so it is envisaged that the Chair would eventually become a Director and Treasurer on the Board of Trustees.

We have raised approximately £200,000 to get going over the next two years. We have established some financial management processes and rules in collaboration with the organisation that is currently hosting the organisation's activities whilst it becomes established; Middlesbrough Voluntary Development Agency, itself a registered charity.

We welcome applications from individuals who:

- Lived experience of racism is a preferred but not essential criterion
- Have a strong connection to the north east of England and can attend face to face meetings in the region occasionally

Time Commitment

- One meeting per month (approximately one hour, plus preparation)
- Occasional contact or follow-up work between meetings

Expenses

• The role is voluntary, but out-of-pocket expenses can be reimbursed
